

### THE IMPACT ON BLACK FEMALE AND BLACK MALE STUDENTS

At the elementary/middle school level, schools in the rest of Erie County were 12.2X more likely to suspend Black female students than White female students.

At the **elementary/middle school level**, **Buffalo Public Schools** suspended **21.4 percent** of American Indian male students, which is a greater rate than any other group of students.

At the **high school level**, schools in the **rest of Erie County** were **5.9X** more likely to suspend Black female students than White female students.

At the **high school level**, **Buffalo Public Schools** suspended **30.7 percent** of Black male students, which is a greater rate than any other group of students.
